6 RED SNOOKER

The following rules are issued by the International Billiards & Snooker Federation for use in 6 Red Snooker, updated December 2013.

The usual Rules of Snooker apply with the following exceptions:

- 1. There will be no more than five consecutive FOUL AND A MISS calls at any one time.
- 2. After four consecutive FOUL AND A MISS calls, the referee will warn the offending player that should a FOUL AND A MISS be called again the following options are available to the non-striker:
- (a) play himself from where the balls have come to rest;
- (b) ask his opponent to play from where the balls have come to rest;
- (c) place the cue-ball anywhere on the table, but this option cannot be taken if play has reached the "snookers required" stage.
- 3. A player cannot snooker behind a nominated colour at any time.
